On Thursday, the children in Year 1 and 2 completed a session with a performer from the West End in School's company. During the sessions, the children acted and danced to music linked to either story of Flat Stanley or Where the Wild Things Are. This was a fantastic experience which I know the children and staff really enjoyed. The school definitely has some budding performers in the making. After seeing the excitement of the children, I am already looking forward to the Christmas Performances.

As set out in the letter regarding the Christmas performances, families have the opportunity to apply for up to 2 tickets. This is to ensure that every family has the opportunity to attend the performances and allowing the school to still comply with health and safety requirements. I fully understand that some families would love to have more tickets than the two available but unless tickets are remaining unallocated before the performance the school will be unable to meet any families requests. I have decided that if any families would like to request an additional ticket they can be placed on a year group waiting list at the main office. If tickets are remaining the day before the performances, they will be allocated according to the waiting list.
