

PE and Sports Premium Funding 2021/2022 Overview

Funding allocated during 2021/2022 academic year: £17,710

Cost of planned projects for 2021/2022: £17,710

Overriding indicators for 2021/2022:

- 1. The engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity Chief Medical Officers guidelines recommend that primary school pupils undertake at least 30 minutes of physical activity a day in school.
- 2. The profile of PESSPA being raised across the school as a tool for whole school improvement.
- 3. Increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport.
- 4. Broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils.
- 5. Increased participation in competitive sport.

HINS' areas to improve further identified at the end of 2020/2021:

Improve the equipment the children have available to them during break and lunch sessions allowing these sessions to be more physically challenging.

Arrange further CPD training for staff as per outcomes of questionnaires and monitoring.

Continue to work with staff alongside coaches to improve the quality of PE teaching - CPD.

Further embed the school's PE assessment system.

Establish and promote more links between the school and local sports clubs/facilities.

Provide further support for vulnerable groups to access PE/Sport outside of the school day - clubs and camps.

Provide more opportunities/competitions for the children to experience more competitive sport.

Provide more opportunities to complete clubs before, during and after school.
