This Week's News:

This week the school officially launched our 3PR zones. The school, its pupils and the 3PR team are trying to reduce the traffic and congestion that can build up outside of schools during drop-off and pick-up times. The school's entrances on Scrub Lane, the Avenue and Bilton Road are busy residential areas, which do not accommodate large numbers of vehicles. Moreover, cars parked across driveways or single/double yellow lines pose a danger for road users and pedestrians and inconvenience those looking to leave their property. The main aims of this scheme are set out below -

- 1 Reduce the likelihood of a child being involved in an accident whilst entering the school.
- 2 Reduce the pollution around the immediate areas of the school.

Members of staff will be posted at each of the entrances of the school. As your child passes one of these members of staff, they will be provided with a token as long as they have followed the 3PR parking rules. Two members of staff will stand in Bilton Road at each end of the non-parking zone. A further two members of staff will stand at the school's other entrances (Scrub Lane/ The Avenue).

Staff will be at their 3PR zones between 8:25am and 8:50am - this will ensure staff are back in classrooms ready to start teaching at 8:55am. Any children who enters the school premises after 8:50am, may not receive their token.

Once the children have collected their token, they will need to place it in their class's token pot. At the end of each week, the tokens will be added up and the class with the highest number of tokens will win a trophy. The winner this week was Turtles Class.
