The YMCA have provided money collection pots for each class, therefore, we will be **ONLY** be accepting **CASH** donations on Monday 15th July.

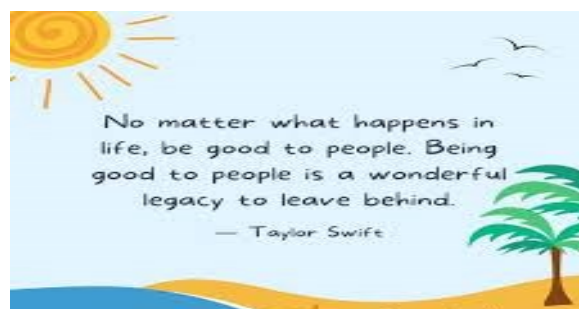

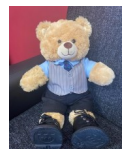
