EYFS 3-4 Year olds (Nursery)	Create closed shapes with continuous lines and begin to use these shapes to represent objects. Draw with increasing complexity and detail, such as representing a face with a circle and including details. Use drawing to represent ideas like movement or loud noises. Show different emotions in their drawings and paintings, like happiness, sadness, fear, etc. Explore colour and colour mixing. Explore different materials freely to develop their ideas about how to use them and what to make Develop their own ideas and then decide which materials to use to express them Join different materials and explore different textures
Reception statements	Explore use and refine a variety of artistic effects to express their words and feelings Return to, and build on their previous learning, refining ideas and developing their ability to represent them Create collaboratively sharing ideas resources and skills

Key knowledge for each theme

Nursery - Know that something that has been drawn is a picture.

Know that pictures can be made in different ways – drawing, painting, putting resources such as different coloured paper or found items together.

Know that colours can be changed when they are mixed together.

Identify how they will create their artwork before they start to make.

Know that materials can be joined together.

Know that different materials feel different.
