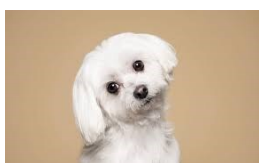
## Hadleigh Heroes

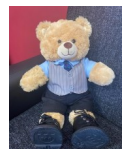
