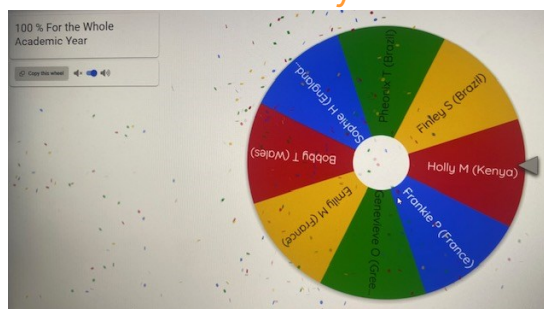

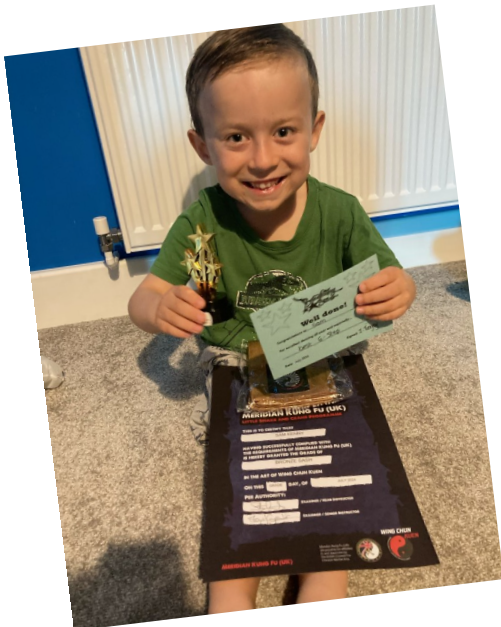


Out of School Achievements
